



HOW TO MAKE A STORYBOARD

A storyboard tells the story of an animation panel by panel. Storyboards are drawn in pen or pencil, but you can also use photos or pictures from magazines. You have to draw each frame within a rounded edged rectangle.

Above the rectangle you have to write:

- the name of the story;
- the number of the scene;
- the number of the frame;
- the date.

On the right of the rectangle you have to write:

- which characters are in the frame and how they move;
- what the characters say;
- how much time has passed between the last frame of the storyboard and the current one;
- where the camera is during the scene and if it moves (you can indicate it with arrows on the drawing).
